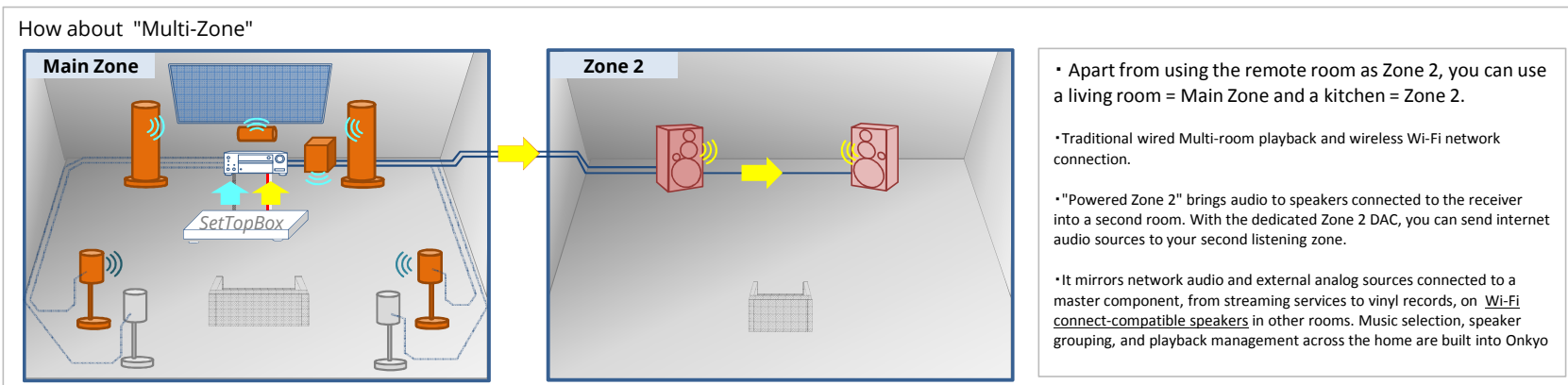
Install A : Connect Two speakers directly to receiver for Zone 2 use.

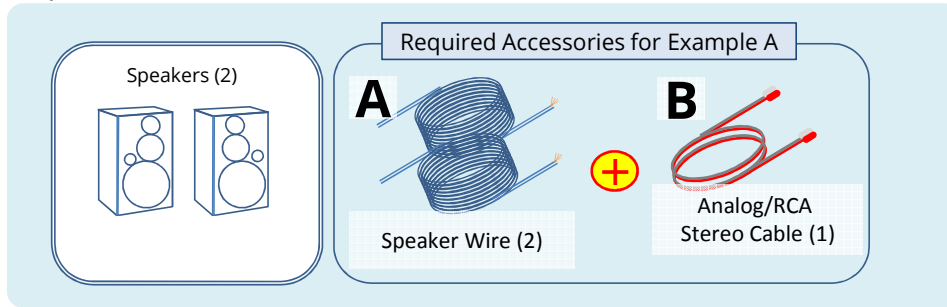

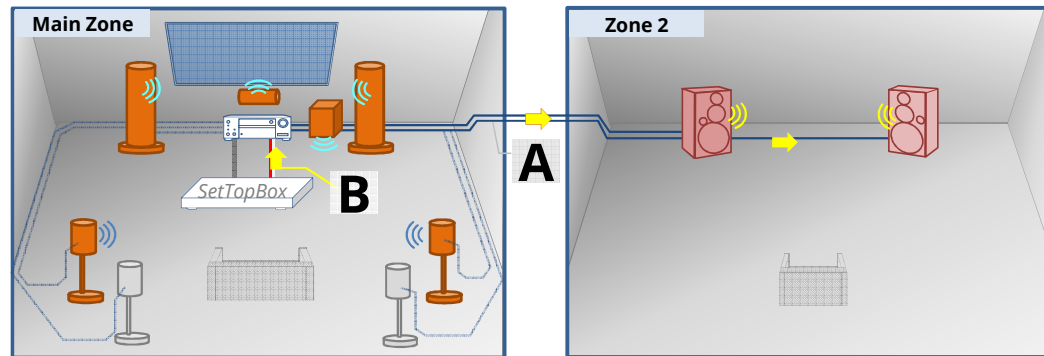

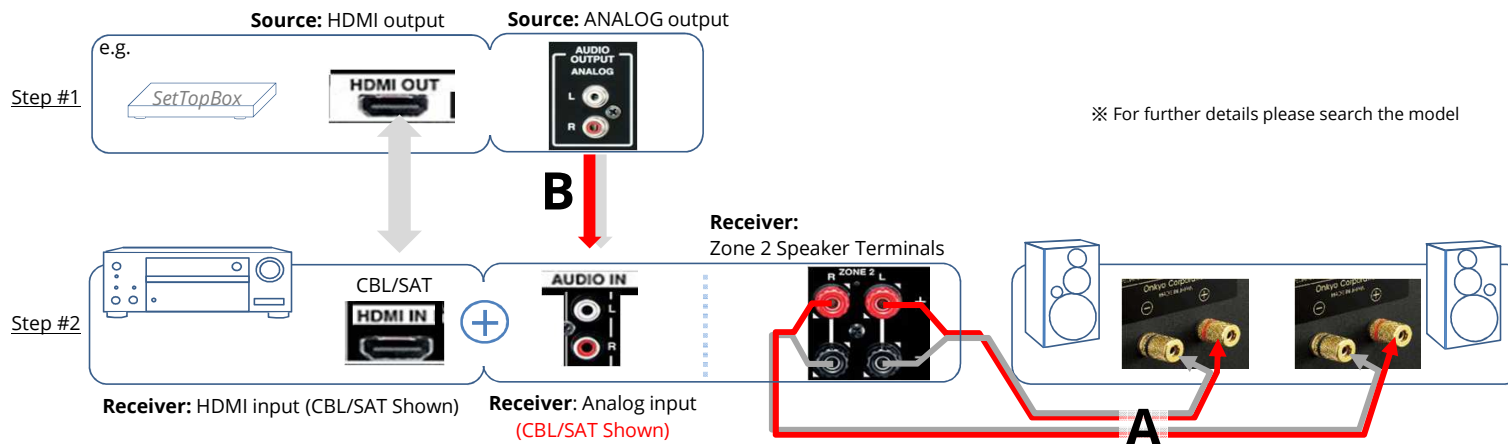


[2] Configuration Layout

- This layout shows Set-Top Box connected to the receiver with two speakers connected to the "Powered Zone 2" terminals on the receiver.



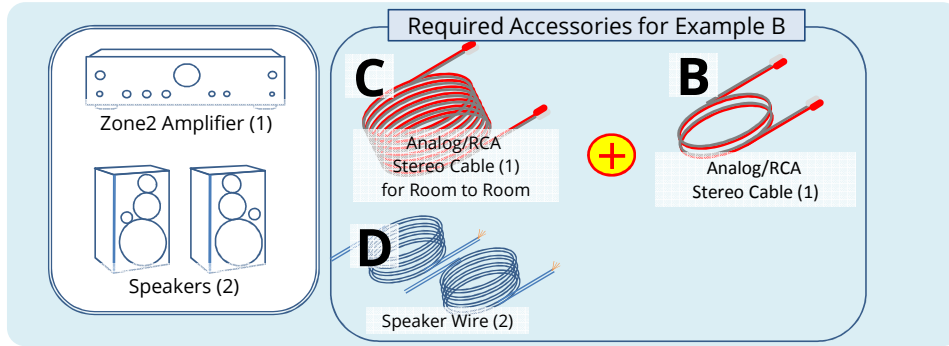

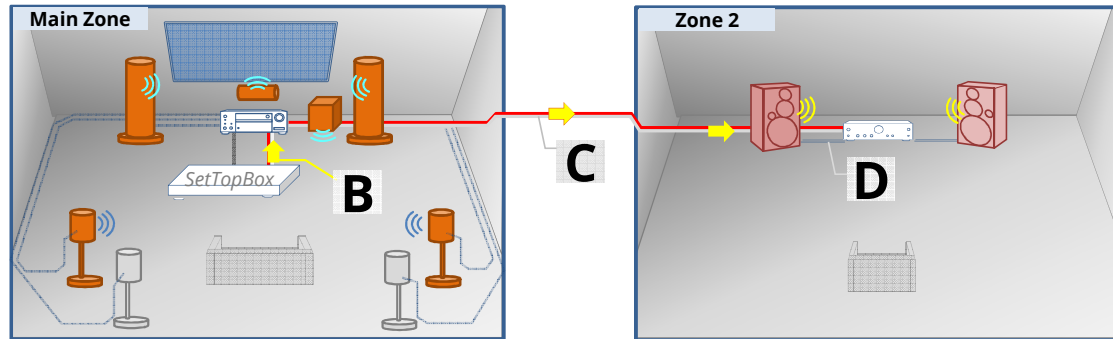

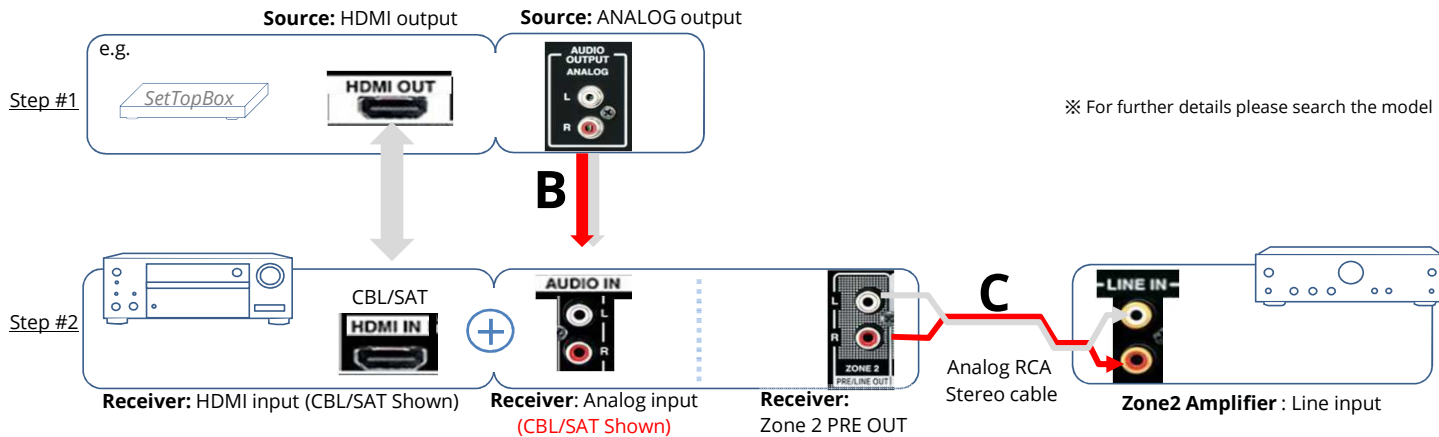
[2] Configuration Layout
